

COLOUR & FINISH GUIDE

Frame the view in your colour.

A practical, visual guide to choosing a window or door finish that belongs with the architecture.

START WITH CONTEXT

Coordinate the frame with exterior cladding, interior trim, roofing and the visual weight you want around the opening.



Explore the colour collection. 1 / 3

Digital and printed samples are approximate. Confirm colour and finish with a physical sample.



Samples are ordered from brightest to darkest. Metallic Gray and Alu Copper samples show colour only, not metallic sheen. Finish availability depends on the selected product.

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See the frame before choosing the finish.

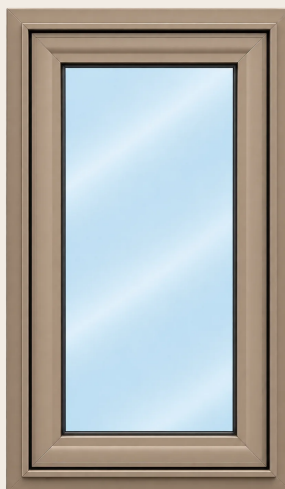
Three Morrison window presentations show how colour changes profile definition, visual weight and the relationship to the building.



400 SERIES

Riviera Blue

A cool architectural blue that defines the profile without reading as black.



775 SERIES

Sand Brown

A warm neutral that connects naturally with masonry, wood and earth-toned materials.



775 SERIES

Polo Charcoal

A strong installed finish that creates a precise outline against a light exterior wall.

Compare digital references with an approved physical sample in the project's actual light.

Bring the finish back to the project.

01 Compare outside

View the sample beside cladding, masonry, roofing and flashing.

02 Compare inside

Check walls, trim, flooring, cabinetry and hardware.

03 Review the whole elevation

Consider how repeated frames affect rhythm and visual weight.

04 Confirm the exact product

Finish availability can vary by window or door series and project timing.

05 Approve a physical sample

Printed and digital colours are useful guides, not final colour standards.
